## **Who we are**

The Friends of the Library (FOL) is a charitable association that supports improved services and facilities of the library by donating money raised by the bookstore and other fundraising. It is also dedicated to improving access to reading materials by the community.

## ***How Can You Support the Friends of the Library?***

### **Membership**

Those interested in supporting the Library can become a Friend by purchasing a membership. The current fee is \$10 annually. There are no meetings to attend and volunteering is optional. You can also purchase a Lifetime Membership for \$150 for which a tax receipt will be provided.

### **Volunteers**

A group of dedicated volunteers staff the FOL Used Book Store which is the main source of revenue for the organization. If you wish to volunteer for the book store please keep in mind that the position requires some mildly strenuous aspects. These include such activities as lifting and carrying boxes of books and stretching and bending to reach higher and lower shelves. The main duties are greeting customers, stocking and organizing shelves, handling and counting money and keeping the store clean. PLEASE NOTE: A Criminal Reference Check may be required if you wish to volunteer as a bookstore staffer.

You can also volunteer to assist the executive with fundraising events, help in designing marketing materials or to become a member of the Executive Committee.
